Welcome to our Impact Report, showcasing and celebrating SIEVEMK's achievements since the organisation was founded in 2007. Now in our fourteenth year, as in our first, we remain committed to our mission: *Creating Opportunities, Delivering Excellence and Changing Lives.* This continues to drive our world view, activities, and initiatives, as well as our partnerships and projects. Our mission has underpinned our development and continues to push us to grow, learn and improve the services we provide to our learners and customers.

The last year has been like no other. In March 2020, almost overnight, the pandemic changed our lives and our community dramatically. Our plans and ways of working had to change too, to ensure we could support the learners who needed our support and guidance more than ever. Despite closing our doors physically for most of the last 12 months, we are proud to say we have raised £112,000 and continued to support over 180 learners this year.

We are excited to announce an update to the SIEVEMK brand and image. SIEVEMK started in 2007, as a supplementary education initiative for 'ethnic minority kids'. Today we are SMK, a platform, driving multiple initiatives and programmes that improve access to education, academic achievement and employability to learners and service users of all ages. The SMK identity reflects our widened scope and reach and provides a relevant and recognisable brand identity for the organisation we are today.

SIEVEMK's Expanding Horizons

As our city continues to grow, so does the demand for our services and the requirement to remain relevant to the needs of the communities within Milton Keynes. We are proud to announce two initiatives that will amplify our community impact.

SMK Alternative Provision – After a rigorous UK OFSTED inspection SIEVEMK now has Department of Education approval to operate as an Alternative Provision School. SMK Alternative Provision will focus on the delivery of the key stage four curriculum to students with behavioural issues. We will be able to work with individual students to give them the support and stability they need to reintegrate into mainstream education.

SMK Community & Learning Centre – We have embarked on a £1.5million capital programme to develop a purpose-built community and learning centre. The centre will not only serve the community of Heelands, it will be a home to a social enterprise hub, examination centre and community cafe.


SchoolsMK Project (2015-2018)

Funded by the Paul Hamley Foundation



In 2015 SIEVEMK obtained a three year grant (of \pm 120K) from the Paul Hamlyn Foundation to address the high incidence of academic underachievement among young people from Black and Minority Ethnic (BME) groups and migrant communities in Milton Keynes. The project benefitted a total of 192 BME learners from two mainstream secondary schools and two primary schools over a three year period from 2015-2018.

SIEVEMK's successful partnership with The Royal National Children's SpringBoard Foundation continues to transform the lives of students from disadvantaged backgrounds across Milton Keynes by providing them with opportunities to achieve an excellent education and valuable life experiences.

Through the support SIEVEMK Arlette became a Royal SpringBoard scholar.

Arlette was a student at Stantonbury International School and took classes at SIEVEMK to support her studies for the English and Maths GCSE's.

SIEVEMK introduced Arlette to the Royal National Children's Springboard Foundation and the opportunity to move to a private boarding school for A-levels.

SIEVEMK helped Arlette in finding a boarding school and supported Arlette through the application and entrance examination process. After achieving GCSE grades she needed, Arlette was successful in securing a place at Wymdondham College to study Economics, Business, French and Maths A Levels.

For Arlette, life at Wymdondham College was a huge contrast to the schools she had previously attended and provided many different experiences which she might not have otherwise had. Examples include taking part in open mornings, a wide variety of extra curricula activities and sports, and taking part in projects such as 'Young Enterprise'.

Reflecting on her experience as a student at the college, Arlette felt that attending the college with its smaller class sizes enabled her to have more contact time with teachers and get the support she needed to succeed academically.

SIEVEMK is instrumental in supporting students like Arlette to improve their life chances so that they can set goals for a brighter future and have every chance of achieving them. Arlette is grateful for the opportunities that SIEVEMK created for her and the support the organisation has given her throughout her academic career.
